

## PREFACE

The *Early Judaeo-Persian Tafsīrs of Ezekiel* are part of the *Friedberg Genizah Project*.

The Friedberg Genizah Project (FGP) was initiated by Mr. Albert D. Friedberg of Toronto, Canada, who foresaw the fascinating possibilities of harnessing modern information technology in order to advance international research into the riches of the Cairo Genizah. The hundreds of thousands of Genizah fragments around the world include Bible texts and commentaries, rabbinic dictionaries, halakhic works, poetry, liturgical texts, philosophical and polemic treatises, commercial documents and letters. This sea of primary source material – written in Hebrew, Aramaic, Judaeo-Arabic, Arabic, Judaeo-Persian and Yiddish – dates from the 8<sup>th</sup> century until after the 15<sup>th</sup> century. The Genizah is a window on nearly 1000 years of Jewish and Middle Eastern history, scholarship and daily life. The FGP will open this window wider than ever before, launching a new era in Genizah scholarship.
