The T'ung-tzu Ho, looking downstream towards its junction with the Pa-pao Ho (Hei-kou Ho) and to the southern slopes of the Ma-lo-ho Shan about 15000 feet in height, a part of the Ch'i-lien Shan range. Elevation 9000 feet.



42 (p. 142)

The Tshe Chhu (River) on the Na-mo-gen Thang (Plain) at an elevation of 12050 feet. The encampment of the Rong-wo nomads in the middle distance, the spur in the background is Na-mo-ri-ön-dza-de. The nomads taking their sheep out to graze after having been in the center of their encampment for the night. Our camp was on the terrace to the left above the river.
