
Plates 349

A Tshang-gur Go-log at his encampment west of the Yellow River. The scars on his abdomen are from self-inflicted burns resorted to as counter-irritation against indigestion. Around his neck he wears an amulet containing charms.

82 (p. 206) The chief of the Bu-tshang Go-log, his encampment is south of the Ri-mang Go-long and west of the Nga-ba tribe, south of the Yellow River. He wears a rich blue satin brocade with gold designs, trimmed with otter skins, and on his head a fox skin. Around his neck is a fine silver charm box studded with turquoise and coral.
