About the appendices

The following sections contain annotated translations of material that is helpful in understanding the *Apoahasiddhi*. The purpose of these sections is therefore not to study all these passages in detail, but only to provide a basic understanding of their general intent, scope, and arguments. As a consequence of this, it will probably not be very useful to read these passages, often not more than sketches, separately from the discussions in the previous sections that reference them and define the respect in which they are interesting.

The Sanskrit literary genre of commentaries (see Tubb and Boose 2007: 1 ff.) has various characteristic techniques for explaining the text commented upon. One case that occurs often in the passages translated below is the verbatim quotation of words or phrases from the base text. In the translations below, these cases are marked graphically by **bold face**.
